

BATTLESHIP BINGO

Explanation, Rules and Regulations

Battleship Bingo is a field game, played on a 60 X 50 square yard area marked off into square yard "Deeds". Each square yard represents an "ocean deed" that corresponds with a numbered ticket (0001 to 3000). Each "deed" sells for \$5.00.

All "deeds" are numbered at random by computer prior to the start of the game. A chart will display the location of each deed purchased during the game.

On the day of the Chili Cook-off, at approximately 1:00 pm, five Bando Battleships will head out onto the sea of "ocean deed" grids. Five other Bandos will launch water balloons from a catapult, hoping to score a "hit" upon the battleships. After a hit has been verified, all play will stop and the hit will be marked. The game will then resume, until all 5 battleships have been hit.

Once each "ocean deed" has been recorded on the numbered chart, the winnings are paid as follows:

- 1st "hit" wins \$100.00
- 2nd "hit" wins \$150.00
- 3rd "hit" wins \$200.00
- 4th "hit" wins \$350.00
- 5th "hit" wins \$650.0

If all parcels are not sold, the winning prizes will be equivalent to 10% of the total amount purchased under State of California non-profit rules.

If a "hit" happens on a line, between tow deeds, the prize money will be divided equally among the deed owners, regardless of volume on each deed.

If the "hit" lands on an unsold lot, the measurement will move one deed north and clockwise to find a winner.

Winners need not be present to win.

Other rules apply as stated on your "ocean deed" ticket.
