The El Modena Band & Color Guard will be holding our second annual "Cow" Chip Bingo fundraiser that is very different and a lot of fun. It involves no cookie dough, wrapping paper, or candy, and can make a lot of money for your student account. By selling all 40 of your tickets you will make \$100.00 for your student account.

On Saturday, September 18, one "bando cow" will be brought to the El Modena High School football practice field. This cow (actually a couple of band students in a cow costume!) will be led blindly to the marked area by student volunteers. When the cow "plops," the location is measured and the ticket which corresponds to the area where it plops is the winning ticket. This activity will be repeated two more times, to determine three total winners.

The first "plop" earns the ticket holder \$250 (and the student who sold it \$50); the second one earns the ticket holder \$500 (and the student who sold it \$75); and the third "plop" earns the ticket holder \$750 (and the student who sold it \$100).

This fundraiser not only earns the winner some money, but the Band and Color Guard some much-needed funds. It should be an interesting and fun Saturday afternoon! Come join us! Bring a chair and buy some lunch from the Bando Café. We will also be holding this event in conjunction with our Big Band Boutique, so there will be plenty of vendors to hold your attention (think Holiday shopping!) while awaiting our illustrious "cows."
